Information about COVID 19 and necessity education

Dear parents

COVID 19 has created an exceptional situation in our schools and after-school programs. The government has decided that all schools and after-school programs will close beginning Monday the 16th of March and reopen Monday the 30th of March 2020. However, it is possible to receive necessity education for your child, if it is under 10 years of age.

Do you need necessity education for your child?

Children under the age of 10, can be looked after and receive lessons in the following two weeks, if you as parents are required to work and have no one else to look after your child.

We are working as hard as we can to find a good solution for necessity education and the education of the children, who are at home in the weeks to come.

Later this afternoon, you will receive further instructions regarding necessity education. The letter will contain information as to who you must contact and notify if you need necessity education.

We ask that you immediately try to find out which other options you have for child care the next two weeks, so that you can notify the school regarding necessity education and the school bus, before 10 a.m. tomorrow, Friday the 13th of March.

Student education in the coming weeks


The government's aim, is that students shall receive as much schooling as possible in the time period, where they can't physically be at school.

The teachers are working on a plan for how the students can work from home. You will receive further information regarding this, at a later time.

Stay updated on the school's website and facebook-profile. We will also post information on AULA, but right now there are technical difficulties with the platform. We will continually update our information.

In the letter you will receive this afternoon, the principal will give more information about the schooling. The letter will also contain the necessary contact information regarding necessity education, schooling at home and other questions.
